Our property


'Bayview Farm', is 288ac of coastal land adjoining Westernport Bay at Lang Lang in West Gippsland. The farm is accredited as a 'Land for Wildlife' property, and during our time here we have worked hard towards enhancing the property as a haven for wildlife. This has included fencing off all of the remnant vegetation, providing wildlife corridors and revegetating a coastal strip of 1.6 kilometres

The proximity of the property to the coast means it is vital to ensure that farming practices do not impact on the bay. Through our Environmental Management System we have been able to identify problem areas and put management practices in place to overcome these problems.

Our involvement with environmental management systems, and 'Enviromeat' has sprung from a wish to integrate our love of the Land, our cattle and the environment into a sustainable system.
