MSA ON-FARM REQUIREMENTS

Cattle

- · Consign cattle with an MSA vendor declaration
- Cattle must be held on the same property for at least one month prior to dispatch
- · No mixing or drafting of pens within 2 weeks of dispatch
- · Direct consignment cattle must be processed by the day after dispatch
- · Saleyard cattle must be processed within 36 hours of dispatch

Sheep

- Consign with National vendor declaration
- · Minimum fat score 2
- · Sheep not to be shorn within 2 weeks prior to processing, >5mm wool length
- · Must be processed within 48 hours off feed

MLA MEMBER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration criteria

In this form:

Producer means a person engaged in the raising or finishing of livestock for production or for live export and includes:

- (a) a person engaged in the raising or finishing of cattle for production or for live export. For this purpose cattle are bovine animals other than buffaloes and include calves but exclude grainfed cattle;
- (b) a person engaged in the finishing of grainfed cattle for production or for live export. For this purpose grainfed cattle are grainfed cattle that are eligible for GF or GFYG certification or third party audited certification approved by AUS-MEAT Limited ACN 082 528 881 attesting that cattle are being fed to at least the AUS-MEAT Limited minimum standard for grainfed beef;
- (c) a person engaged in the raising or finishing of sheep for production or for live export. For this purpose sheep includes lambs; and
- (d) a person engaged in the raising or finishing of goats for production or for live export.

Levies are levies or charges imposed on producers of livestock under the following Acts:

- (a) the Primary Industries (Customs) Charges Act 1999; and
- (b) the Primary Industries (Excise) Levies Act 1999.

Registration details

Two or more individuals and/or body corporates named in this form are taken to be a single member of MLA.

The address (or postal address if provided) and facsimile number given by the applicant will be used by MLA for the giving of notices and other communications from MLA.

Voting at general meetings

All members are entitled to one vote at MLA general meetings (and, for class votes, one vote for each class to which the member belongs).

For members to be entitled to more than one vote at MLA general meetings, the information referred to in the MLA Levies Notice must be provided to MLA by the return date fixed by the Directors of MLA inaccordance with article 2.6(b) of MLA's constitution. Where:

- (a) this information is not provided by that return date; or
- (b) this application is received by MLA after that return date,

there will only be an entitlement to one vote (as described above) at general meetings held prior to the following year's return date.

Joint members votes can only be exercised jointly, not individually.
